Topic 'Scotland'

'Myths and Legends'

Myths and legends are types of stories which have been passed down from generation to generation often by word of mouth. A myth is a made up story from a very long time ago and explain how something happened. A legend is a story about a true person. It is told again and again over time and grows and changes to sound more interesting. Scottish myths and legends include the story of Robert the Bruce and the Spider and mysterious creatures like the Loch Ness Monster, the unicorn and kelpie.
